## ADDITIONAL NOTE

Two Rhubarb operations by 263 Squadron on the  $19^{\text{th}}$  October resulted in claims of two locomotives Cat B at the Valognes - Montebourg - Carentan junction and siding and 1 locomotive Cat B (Probably Cat A, but insufficient evidence) at Neuilly, four miles N.N.W of Airel. Composite reports cover the relevant information derived from these operations except that the two pilots of the second operation P/O Blacklock and F/Sgt Beaumont have recollected the following information:

- 1. 15 20 sailing fishing vessels without escorting motor-launch were seen 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles W.N.W of Port en Bessin at 145/19 October.
- 2. A goods train without engine was being loaded by a crane standing on a platform in the one track siding N of the main line at Le Molay (Army/Air Sheet 3a and 8 T6677).
- 3. The flak reported 3 miles S.E of Isigny has now been pinpointed with some confidence as coming from the high wooded ground near Monfreville (Army Air 3a and 8 T5483)

Pilots now add the following observations about it:

Our A/C were at 100 feet. Intense flak came from several positions (judged 3 or 4) all around them and burst in orange bursts at the same height or just above our A/C, within fifty feet of them. Both pilots are confident that this flak came from positions close around them and not from the Isigny area ( $2 \, \frac{1}{2} \,$  miles) or other similar distance. They have the strong impression that it was light flak bursting at close range (e.g. at 200-400 yards range. But they did not see any gun positions or tracer. Any available information as to the possibility of this type of closerange burst is requested by this unit.
