F/Lt McClure led through patches of cloud to within 4 miles of target Brest/Guipavas The escort- But 10/10 cloud there prevented d/b, therefore returned to base. Those who wished dropped their bombs N of Fr. Coast. Sgt Green's were dropped "safe" from 100 feet and their splashes were seen. About 10 seconds later, an explosion in the water made a large hole in his stbd engine L glycol leak soon made it U/S. He switched off L flew back to a good S.E landing. Squadron opinion is that his a/c set off an acoustic mine – unconnected with bomb-dropping. Escort by Perranporth Wing simply disappeared after crossing inwards over French Coast
